Published by the Nlaka'pamux Nation Tribal Council, under the direction of by Justice Ardith Walkem, this guidebook critically examines how the federal Act <i>respecting First Nations, Inuit and Métis children, youth and families</i> creates space for Indigenous Peoples to pass their own laws and establishes national standards that all provincial and territorial child welfare providers must meet. <i>Wrapping Our Ways</i> is intended to be a resource that empowers Indigenous Nations and community involvement in caring for Indigenous children.
